## Information you can trust

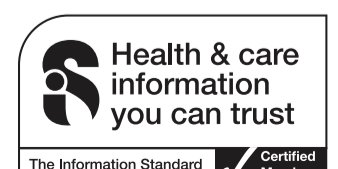
Our website provides practical information, addressing the issues which parents can face when caring for their child at home. The information is written by children's doctors and pharmacists, and checked by parents like you.
